## **THE CITY OF WINNIPEG**

#### **BY-LAW NO. 52/2017**

A By-law of THE CITY OF WINNIPEG to amend the Municipal By-law Enforcement Act (MBEA) Enabling By-law

**WHEREAS** the Province of Manitoba has enacted two statutes, *The Municipal By-law Enforcement Act* (MBEA) and *The Provincial Offences Act* (POA), which together provide three options for the enforcement of City by-laws;

**AND WHEREAS** The Municipal By-law Enforcement Act has already been proclaimed into law and, through the Municipal By-law Enforcement Act (MBEA) Enabling By-law, applies to all by-law parking offences;

**AND WHEREAS** the City of Winnipeg has the option of having other by-law offences enforced through *The Municipal By-law Enforcement Act*;

**AND WHEREAS** it is anticipated that *The Provincial Offences Act* will be proclaimed and come into force within the next weeks or months;

**AND WHEREAS**, when in force, *The Provincial Offences Act* will replace *The Summary Convictions Act* and thereafter all City by-law offences will be enforceable through its provisions unless the City chooses to have them enforced through *The Municipal By-law Enforcement Act*;

**AND WHEREAS** it is prudent for the City to anticipate the proclamation of *The Provincial*Offences Act by determining in advance which by-law offences will be enforceable by way of

The Municipal By-law Enforcement Act once The Provincial Offences Act is proclaimed into law;

**THE CITY OF WINNIPEG**, in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

#### MBEA Enabling By-law amended

1 The Municipal By-law Enforcement Act (MBEA) Enabling By-law No. 59/2016 is amended this By-law.

#### Section 5 amended

Section 5 is amended by replacing "discounted amount" with "Early Payment Discount".

### Subsection 12(1) amended

- 3 Subsection 12(1) is amended by replacing the period at the end of subclause 12(1)(d)(iv) with a semi-colon and adding the following immediately after it:
  - (v) In the case of a parking contravention, the following situation exists:
    - the by-law contravened is the Winter Parking Ban By-law No. 76/2011;
    - the driver of the vehicle resides outside of Winnipeg or is newly resident in Winnipeg;

- the driver was not aware of the parking restriction that was contravened and could not reasonably be expected to have been aware of it; and
- the driver has not had a penalty notice or ticket issued to him or her for a contravention of the Winter Parking Ban By-law within the previous five years.

4 Schedule A is replaced with Appendix 1 to this By-law.

## **Coming into force**

This By-law comes into force on the day that Schedule A of *The Provincial Offences Act* and *Municipal By-law Enforcement Act*, S.M. 2013, c.47 comes into force.
